


The institution is using **Contineo software** and it is user friendly having modules such as **Admission and Fees, Student information Management System (SIMS), Examination** and **OBE**. The institution had made complete automation of examination processes, which helped in the successful execution of examination processes. The following diagram represents the **PROCESS FLOW** of the whole examination system.



1. Pre-Examination

The registration details of the students are imported from the **admission module** as and when the admission process is completed. Further, the pre-examination work is carried out in **Student Information Management System (SIMS) module** of Contineo software. The verification of course credits for each course, creation of courses and setting maximum marks of CIE and SEE for each course is conceded by the Department Co-ordinators/ Course Co-ordinators. The allocation of courses to the students, batch creation for laboratory courses, student allotment to the proctors/mentors, creating a time table and assigning faculty to the respective sections is accomplished. The **attendance** for each class on an hourly basis will be marked by the concerned faculty with their login credentials. The **question paper template** is created for each course and made ready for the entry of the marks. The **examination notification** is given for the payment of examination fee specifying the **tentative examination schedule** prior to the movement of data from SIMS to the Examination module.

The **model question papers** are prepared for each course and made available to the students. The consolidated list of examiners, QP setters and valuers are availed from departments after having online meeting with Board of Studies of different disciplines. The appointment order for the QP setting is sent to the faculty in the ratio of 70:30 as per the academic rules and regulations of BITM. The **Board of Examiners (BoE) meeting** is held to scrutiny the received question papers. Further, the question papers are prepared as per the standard format and preserved in a safe locker.

2. Post-Examination

Primarily the transferred data from the SIMS is verified in the **Examination module**. The **hall tickets** are printed and will be distributed to the students 2 to 3 days prior to the examination. The **seating arrangement** is done in a separate tab of examination module “seating arrangement” with which the **layout of seating arrangement, Form B** and **block-wise QP requirement** reports are generated. The absentees will be entered, in turn **Form-A** comprises of list of presentees and absentees are generated. Further, the data is synched to the evaluation board. After synching, the **coding of answer scripts** is done by generating bar code. The software does the randomization of answer scripts and the list is generated. Each packet with a **packet code** consists of 15 scripts are arranged based on the list and made ready to allocate to the valuator.

The **appointment orders for valuation** of each course are sent and the subject meeting is conducted to decide and come to a conclusion about the scheme of evaluation by the senior faculty with subject expertise before the commencement of valuation of each course. The marks are entered in the software by valuers with their login credentials. The software estimates the number of scripts came for moderation based on the pre-defined conditions. The senior faculty having expertise in subject is allocated scripts for moderation. Again, the marks are entered for all moderated scripts in the software by the moderator. Similar kind of procedure is adopted for all the courses and valuation process is accomplished.

The results are processed by the software personnel and the arrangements are made to publish the same after the valuation is completed. The **result sheet** is generated branch-wise and the meeting is held with all Deans, Head of the Departments in the presence of Management to declare the results. The **result link is posted in the college website** and the students are verifying the same using their login credentials.

The students are verifying their answer scripts after the declaration of results. This activity is carried out to bring transparency in the evaluation process and **grievances** are collected if any. Further, the notification for the **Revaluation** followed by the Revaluation of scripts is done. Similar procedure is adopted to complete the valuation and publishing the results of the same. Finally, the **grade cards** are printed and handed over to the departments for further distribution to the students.

Based on the overview and discussion about the examination procedures, the following list of reforms are brought in the examination management system and listed with their impact.
